

**STIPULATION TO DISCONTINUE SHOW CAUSE
PROCEEDING BETWEEN CLAIMANT MARIANNE WRIGHT AND THE AHP
SETTLEMENT TRUST AND TO VACATE PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 5239 IN PART**

Marianne Wright ("Claimant") and the AHP Settlement Trust (the "Trust")
(collectively the "Parties"), hereby stipulate and agree that the Show Cause proceeding
initiated herein by the Trust against Claimant should be discontinued and that Pretrial Order
No. 5239, issued by the Court on May 20, 2005, as it pertains to Claimant Marianne Wright,
should be vacated, without prejudice to claimant's ability to submit a new claim in accordance
with the requirements of the Settlement Agreement as amended in the event that her condition

changes in the future and meets the criteria for Matrix Compensation contained in the Nationwide Class Action Settlement as approved by the United States District Court.
