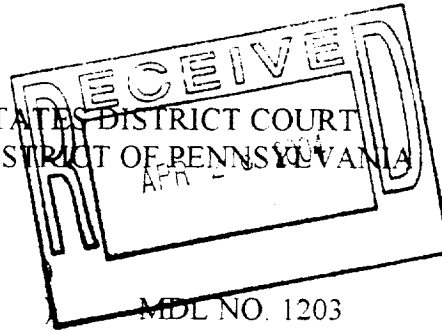

STIPULATION AND PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 3525

AND NOW, this 12th day of May, 2004, it is hereby STIPULATED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, pursuant to Federal Rule of Procedure 41(a)(1)(ii), that the Complaints in the above captioned cases are hereby dismissed without prejudice as to the all the named Defendants, with each party to bear its own costs and counsel fees.

The voluntary dismissal of the defendants are conditioned upon the following:

In the event that these Plaintiffs who are voluntarily dismissing their civil actions decide to initiate a future lawsuit against all or any of the Defendants who have been voluntarily dismissed, the Plaintiffs shall do so in a United States District Court. Any Plaintiff who initiates any such further lawsuit shall be subject to all terms and conditions of the Nationwide Class Action Settlement With American Home Products Corporation (as amended), dated November 18, 1999.

In the event that the above Plaintiffs who are voluntarily dismissing their civil actions initiate a future lawsuit in the US District Court against all or any of the Defendants who have been voluntarily dismissed without prejudice, the Defendants will not seek dismissal by asserting any threshold defense that was not available to Defendants at the time these cases were dismissed including any defense based


on statute of limitations or repose, the doctrines of laches, or any other defense predicated on the failure to timely pursue a claim, as set forth in Sections IV.D.3.c or 4.c of the Nationwide Class Action Settlement with American Home Products Corporation (as amended), dated November 18, 1999.

There are no class action allegations in these complaints.


The above cases are voluntarily dismissed without prejudice in their entirety.






