
STIPULATION AND PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 3096

AND NOW, this 5th day of November, 2003, it is hereby
STIPULATED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED pursuant to Federal Rule of
Civil Procedure Rule 41(a)(1)(ii), that the claims in the Complaint by Plaintiff Shelia
Lotsberg ("Plaintiff Lotsberg") in the above-captioned matter are hereby dismissed
without prejudice as to all Defendants.

Further, Plaintiff Lotsberg agrees that in the event that Plaintiff Lotsberg decides
to initiate a future lawsuit against any or all of the defendants who are being dismissed,
Plaintiff Lotsberg shall file such lawsuit only in a United States District Court and will
present and plead the claim(s) so that the United States District Court has subject matter
jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. Section 1332.


Further, Defendant Wyeth is aware that Plaintiff Lotsberg previously filed a lawsuit against Wyeth in New York state court and is aware that Plaintiff Lotsberg dismissed the New York lawsuit without prejudice. Defendant Wyeth agrees that if Plaintiff Lotsberg decides to initiate a future lawsuit against Defendant Wyeth, Defendant Wyeth will not seek the dismissal of that future lawsuit based on the existence and dismissal without prejudice of the above-captioned lawsuit and/or the New York lawsuit. Defendant Wyeth does not waive any other defenses or rights it may have with respect to a future lawsuit by Plaintiff Lotsberg, including but not limited to the defense of statute of limitations.

The claims of Plaintiffs Clare Tremaine and Gayle Moore were previously subject to stipulations of dismissal filed with the Court on or about July 18, 2003. As a result, all claims by all Plaintiffs against all Defendants are hereby dismissed and the entire Complaint shall be dismissed in accordance with the prior stipulations concerning Plaintiffs Tremaine and Moore and without prejudice with respect to Plaintiff Lotsberg.








