STIPULATION AND PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 3100


AND NOW, this 5th day of November, 2003, it is hereby STIPULATED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(ii), that the Complaint in the above-captioned case is hereby dismissed as to all named Defendants, with each party to bear its own costs and counsel fees. This dismissal shall be with prejudice because Plaintiff Bonnie F. Gauthier fails to meet the definition of Primary Pulmonary Hypertension in the Settlement Agreement.


