Pretrial ORDER 2527


Before this Court is a Motion to Dismiss filed by Rosilind Brown, a putative plaintiff in the above case. The Court orders that the motion is due to be GRANTED for the following reasons:

1. Rosilind Brown did not file a request for exclusion prior to March 30, 2000, as required by the Nationwide Class Action Settlement Agreement With American Home Products Corporation dated November 18th, 1999 and Approved in January 2002, as amended (hereinafter the "Settlement"). Hence, she was improperly included as a Plaintiff in the Amick case.

2. This dismissal is without prejudice to any rights Rosilind Brown may have to pursue a claim under the Intermediate or Back End Opt Out provisions of the Settlement.
