PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 2045

**(Order Authorizing AHP Settlement Trust to Enter Into Two Contracts
With Ernst & Young LLP)**

AND NOW, this 27th day of JUNE, 2001, it having been represented to the Court by the AHP Settlement Trust (the "Trust") that the Trust has entered into an Agreement for Assessment of Vendor Technology, the services under which constitute Supplemental Services within the meaning of the Agreement for Accounting and Related Services approved by this Court by way of Pretrial Order No. 1580 on May 16, 2001; that the Agreement was negotiated at arms' length; that the Agreement calls for the performance of services which the Trust has considered to be necessary for the effective continuation and completion of its duties and obligations; that the services described therein have been completed and were disclosed to the Parties and the Court at or about the time of

rendition thereof, and that disclosure of the terms of the Agreement would not be in the best interests of the Trust;

It is hereby ORDERED that the AHP Settlement Trust is authorized to enter into an Agreement for Assessment of Vendor Technology with Ernst & Young LLP on terms that are the same as those that were exhibited to the Court.
