ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure
41(a)(1)(ii), that the claims in the complaint in the above captioned matter are hereby dismissed
without prejudice as to American Home Products Corporation, Wyeth-Ayerst Laboratories
Company, Wyeth-Ayerst Laboratories Division of American Home Products Corporation, Wyeth
Laboratories, Inc. and Interneuron Pharmaceuticals, Inc., with each party to bear its own costs
and counsel fees.

Further, the plaintiff agrees that should he decide to institute a case in the future for personal injuries relating to the diet drug litigation, plaintiff shall file said case in federal court.


Plaintiff certifies that he has complied with Pretrial Order No. 22 by producing a completed fact sheet, list of medical providers and properly executed authorization forms.




