
STIPULATION AND PRETRIAL ORDER NO.: 1037


AND NOW, this 3rd day of JAN, 2000, 1999, it is hereby STIPULATED,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure Rule
41(a)(1)(ii), that the claims in the Complaint in the above-captioned matter are hereby dismissed
without prejudice as to all named defendants with each party to bear its own costs and counsel
fees.

Further, the Plaintiff agrees that should she decide to institute a case in the future for
personal injuries relating to diet drug litigation, plaintiff shall file said case in federal court.

Plaintiff certifies that she has complied with Pretrial Order No. 22 by producing a completed Fact Sheet, List of Medical Providers and properly executed Authorization forms. This Stipulation is filed on behalf of all defendants who have appeared in the above-captioned matter, those being American Home Products Corporation, Wyeth-Ayerst Laboratories Company, Wyeth-Ayerst Laboratories Division of American Home Products Corporation, Wyeth Laboratories-Inc., EON Labs Manufacturing, Inc. Zenith Goldline Pharmaceuticals, Inc., and Camall Company, against whom the claims in the complaint shall be dismissed in their entirety by the Court's approval of this Stipulation. ~~The stay relating to proceedings against Interneuron Pharmaceuticals, Inc. does not apply to stipulations of dismissal pursuant to paragraph 5 of Pretrial Order No. 270.~~


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
