Restraining Order in place pursuant to Pretrial Order No. 1061
shall remain in effect.

No. 1061 shall be reduced to \$100.00.
3. Plaintiffs in Brown, et al. V. American Home Products
Corporation, Civil Action No. 99-20593, shall join in American
Home Products Corporation's motion for a preliminary injunction
(Document #201373) and the parties shall be allowed to factually
supplement their briefing as needed. The law firm of Napoli,
Kaiser & Bern, LLP shall file its response to the joint motion by

Wednesday, January 26, 2000.



Napoli, Marc Jay Bern, and Napoli, Kaiser & Bern for an Order Striking Plaintiffs' Motion for an Order to Show Cause, Their "Supplement" to This Motion, and Their Oral Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, and to Have This Court Issue an Order Reiterating the Limited Scope of the Preliminary Injunction Hearing filed on January 20, 2000 is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

5. Plaintiffs' Motion for leave to Take Discovery of SiteLogic Corporation (Document #201372) is GRANTED.
