

AND NOW, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1999, it is hereby STIPULATED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that the claims in the Complaint in the above-captioned matter are hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(ii), in favor of all named defendants with all parties to bear their own costs and counsel fees, and without the need for plaintiff to provide class notice to the putative class alleged in the Complaint, as all class allegation have been stricken from the Complaint under


